**Competition is open to Instrumentalists up to 25 (age as of March 20, 2010) residing in Southern California.**

**Audition fee: \$60**

**Application deadline: March 1, 2010**

As we are limited to 40 participants, mail in your application as soon as possible.

Participants will be notified of their audition time by March 16, 2010.

Repertoire: one movement of a standard concerto or comparable solo with available orchestral accompaniment.

Maximum performance time of eight minutes. (Emphasize solo passages and minimize accompaniment passages.)

Solo must be performed from memory.

Participants must provide their own accompanist.

Winners will be announced by mail. ***Judges' decisions are final.***

Award Winners will receive Young Artists Concerto Awards and will perform with the Torrance Symphony during a regularly scheduled performance.

Previous Award winners who have performed with the Torrance Symphony are welcome to be contestants if they were not winners in the year 2009.

Winners will be expected to supply a biography with color photos, both soft and hard copies, for publicity purposes.

## Directions for getting to the Torrance High School Auditorium

From the Harbor Freeway: Take the Carson exit and go west

From the San Diego Freeway: Take the Crenshaw exit and go south, then go east on Carson

Torrance High School is on the south side of Carson between Crenshaw and Western

Parking for the High School is just opposite El Prado at a 45 degree angle from Carson. Park on the street (the street in front of the school is at a 45 degree angle, the street sign actually says "Carson St.")

The building closest to Carson is called "Main;" on its left is the Admin building; to its left is a gate, through which you enter and the auditorium is just on the left.
